July 7: 1928 Seagrave Engine #2 visits Council on Aging



Come to the Council on Aging on July 7, at 10:15 a.m. to learn about the history of the 1928 Seagrave Engine #2, presented by Lieutenant Barry Herschler, from the Bucyrus Fire Department. The 1928 Seagrave Engine #2 is from the Seagrave Company, Columbus, Ohio. It had an

80 gallon water tank and it pumped 750 gallons of water a minute. Engine #2 was in service at the Bucyrus Fire Department from 1928 to 1964. This Engine was the fourth Seagrave fire vehicle the department purchased. The Seagrave Engine #2 was purchased during Chief William F. Mader's tenure at the Fire Department. He was Fire Chief from July 1, 1888 to July 1, 1953, making him the longest running Fire Chief in the United States. The Department used horse drawn equipment when he became Fire Chief, and it was fully motorized by the end of his reign.

July 9: Happy Birthday Bucyrus party!


