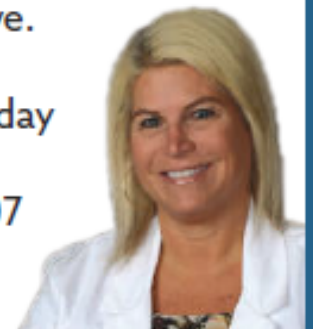

What is Senior Space?

When you walk into the senior center, you'll notice a touchscreen kiosk in the lobby.

What is it? Why is it there?

The kiosk is part of a new system the Council on Aging is using to streamline activities, events and reporting. This system is called **Senior Space** and it's for you!

With Senior Space, you can easily see all activities offered on a given day and sign up for or check-in to your activity. When attending an activity, you will be required to check-in for that activity on the Senior Space kiosk.

In August, we will be rolling out an optional membership program. Those who purchase a membership will receive an ID card to easily check-in the kiosk. Non-members may still check-in to the kiosk using the Guest check-in button.

Memberships will be active 12 months from date of purchase and cost \$30. Members will receive special discounts on activities and other benefits.

Membership fees go directly to the Activities Department and allow us to purchase activity supplies in advance. The Activities Department is self-funded through donations and fundraising events. Levy funds **DO NOT** benefit the Activities department. We rely on you and the community to be able to provide activities.

Can non-members still come in the Center and participate in activities?

YES! A membership is not required to come to the Center or to participate in activities. However, those who purchase memberships may have special privileges such as early sign up, a members-only activity or day trip, discounted prices, etc.

If you regularly participate in activities, a membership will save you money in the long run!

What is We Share?

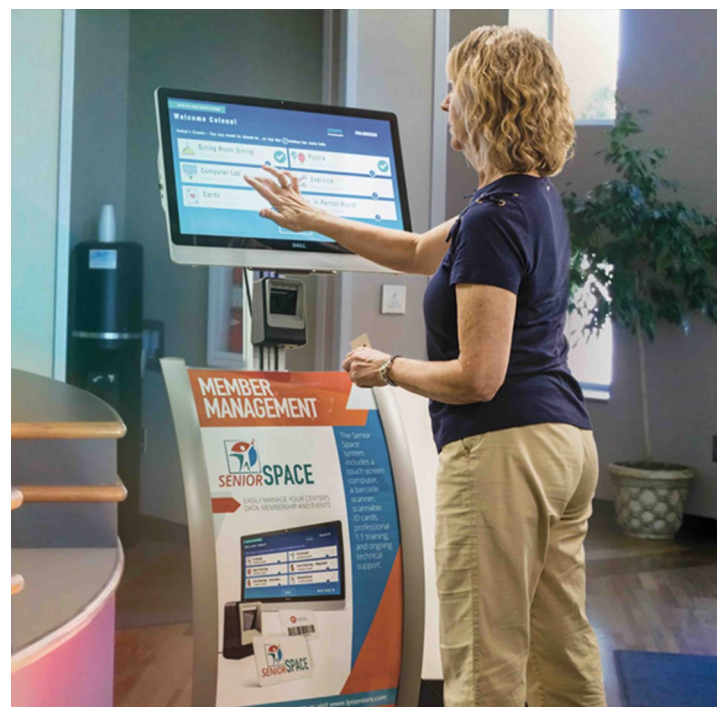
Something else new this year is We Share.
